




Arkansas Juvenile Assessment and Treatment Center (AJATC) is a secure residential facility operated in partnership with the Arkansas Division of Youth Services. Serving both male and female youth ages 10 to 20, AJATC provides comprehensive assessment and treatment services.

The program offers individualized educational support, career and technical training, evidence-based therapeutic interventions, and structured prosocial recreational activities.

2024 Outcomes

- 16 years old was the average age in 2024
- 96% of discharges were successful exits
- 9 High School diplomas and 37 GEDs awarded
- 100% compliance with student IEPs
